I hereby apply to cut and remove hay from the following described land. Please provide section – township – range as well as Road names and drain names if possible.

This application is for the period from the 1st day of June 2024 to the 15th day of October 2026 and is subject to the terms and conditions listed below:

I covenant and Agree:

1. To cut all undesirable growth within the limits of the Permitted Area which can reasonably be cut by a mower.
2. To ensure that, regardless of the condition of the crop, all areas will be cut prior to September 15 of each year and cleaned up, including removal of all bales and haystacks, prior to October 15 of each year.
3. That the crop produced, regardless of the amount or condition, will be considered to be payment in full for all works required to be done under the terms of this Permit.
4. That at no time will I have the right to pasture cattle upon the Permitted Area.

5. To permit access to, in over or upon the Permitted Area to all duly authorized representatives of the Watershed District, Province, and Rural Municipality. The Watershed District or its agents may enter the Permitted Area for the purpose of inspection, maintaining, or constructing works. No compensation shall be paid for any damage to hay crops resulting from such activities.
6. To indemnify and save harmless the Watershed District from and against any and all claims and demands of every kind whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage arising out of the occupancy or sue by the Permittee of the Permitted Area.
7. Where I wish to construct fences or other barriers to prevent trespassers from entering and damaging the Permitted Area, I shall first obtain the written approval of the Watershed District. Fences and barriers shall be provided with 5-meter-wide gates at all locations designated by the Watershed District. The gates shall be locked by a chain cut in two places, thus accommodating the Applicant's lock and the District's lock.
8. Not to accumulate, permit or allow the accumulation on the Permitted Area of any waste material, debris, refuse or garbage.
9. That in the event of failure to comply with the terms of this Permit the Watershed District may cancel this Permit on the giving of seven (7) days notice to the Permittee.
10. That the Watershed District may cancel this Permit on the giving of one hundred and twenty (120) days notice to the Permittee and that no compensation shall be paid for benefits lost or improvements made.
11. That the Watershed District shall be the sole and final judge in respect of matters involving the compliance of this permit.
12. To not assign and rights or benefits obtained by virtue of this permit to others without written permission of the Watershed District and in any case to not request or receive any financial or other benefit from such an assignment.
13. Special Conditions:

Applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Permits will be issued to successful applicants in the Spring of 2024. All applicants will be notified of application results.
